Scar Management 2008: The Turning Point

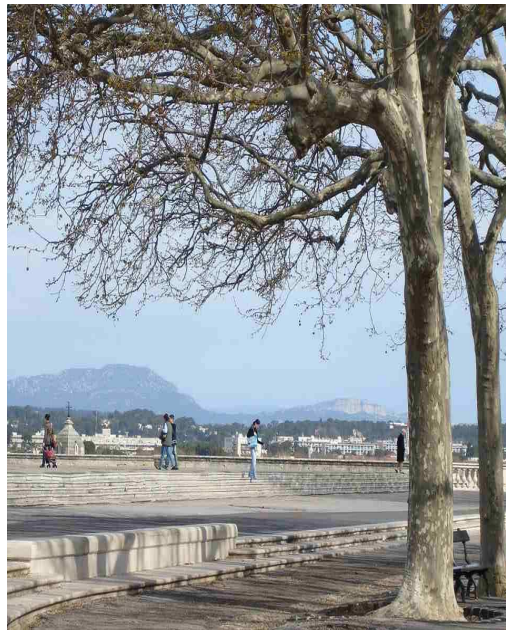
Montpellier, France

We are delighted to announce that the 2nd SCAR Meeting will take place from 25–27 September in Montpellier, in the beautiful Languedoc–Rousillon region of southern France.

Exciting changes to the programme!

The preliminary scientific programme for the meeting has now been updated and adapted from the original planned programme in response to comments received from delegates. The call for more focussed and in-depth handling of specific topics has led us to tailor the programme to include scientific sessions running



simultaneously, in addition to keynote, oral and case study presentations, workshop sessions and an interactive intercontinental telephone conference. Now, delegates are able to choose one of the three topics of interest to them from the simultaneous sessions and attend presentations specifically developed to appeal to all delegates. The meeting is expected to provide delegates with a personalised programme of state of the art developments in the management of scars.

Topics

Adapting the programme has enabled us to include both a greater variety and depth of topics in this 2nd SCAR Meeting. Sessions will include information on the very latest advances in:

- Surgical and non-surgical techniques for preventing excessive scarring
- Evaluation of scars and biological aspects of scarring
- New antiscarring agents and non-surgical techniques for managing scars
- Non-cellularised and cellularised dermal substitutes, and extracellular matrix promoters

- Practical techniques for maintaining moist keratinocytes
- New topics in epidermal cell culture applications
- The latest research into the epidermal component
- New management techniques for post-acne scarring and the prevention of scar recurrence in chronic wounds
- Quality of life in burns patients
- Worldwide issues in the management of scars.

Scientific sessions

The 2nd SCAR Meeting will include:

- Keynote presentations by eminent international speakers
- Simultaneous scientific sessions on the latest advances in scar management
- Interactive telephone conference across five continents discussing issues in the management of scars today
- Patient case study presentations
- Workshop sessions.
